

PRE-TRAVEL CLEARANCE

When entering Austria, the following legal requirements may apply:

- Registration via Pre-Travel-Clearance,
- Presentation of a medical certificate or proof of a valid negative test result for SARS-CoV-2, a vaccination certificate or proof of recovery from SARS-CoV-2 issued in German or English language,
- Observance of a ten-day post-entry quarantine, which may be terminated no earlier than the fifth day after entry by a negative molecular biological test (e.g. PCR test) or antigen test for SARS-CoV-2. The day of entry is considered day „zero“.

Which terms apply depends on the country of exit or residence and the reason for entry.

The following countries are exempt from the restrictions:

Belgium, Bulgaria, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Finland, France, Principality of Liechtenstein, Ireland, Italy, Croatia, Monaco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Sweden, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, Czech Republic, Hungary
